Criteria for Graduate Faculty Status

Approved November 27, 2007

Revised by Graduate Council Membership Committee on February 7, 2008

For membership on the Graduate Faculty of the Department of Sociology, Anthropology, and Criminology, applicants must meet the following minimum criteria:

1. Faculty status in the Department or the Center for Archeological Research.
2. Terminal degree in sociology, anthropology, criminology, criminal justice, or a related field.
3. Three publications in refereed academic journals or a research record judged to be equivalent.
4. Evidence of a continuing and ongoing scholarly agenda in pursuit of various research products, such as publishable outcomes, grant funding, professional conference presentations, or appropriate applied projects.
5. Affirmative vote of approval by a majority of the graduate faculty within the Department of Sociology, Anthropology and Criminology.
